The Challenge!

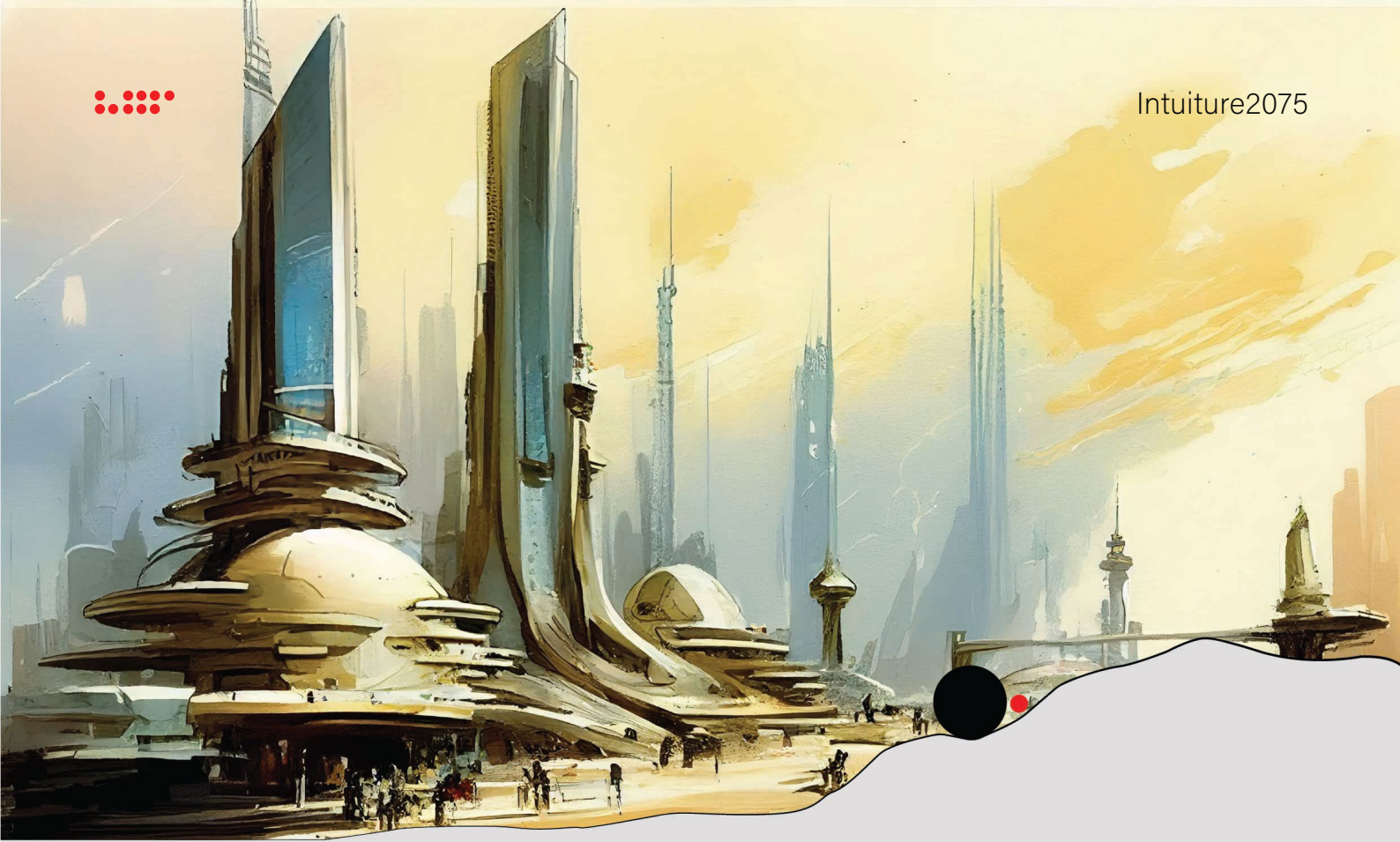

Submission deadline of competition is **30th June 2023.**

Entries that are received after the submission date and time are unlikely to be considered.

Submission sheets should not contain any **personal information.**

The official language of the competition is **English** and must limit to **350** words.

SheetFormat

Participants must submit their entry on a single sheet in **A1** landscape format, with metric units for dimensions.

The team code must be in the lower right corner of the sheet, and the submission should be a **JPEG** file under **10MB** with a resolution of **300 PPI.**

The submission file name must be your **TeamCode** (e.g **1C23XXX**) that you will received during the registration.

The competition is open to **designers, and architecture students.**

Teams are allowed to participate individual or maximum **3 members.**

Definitions

- **Define "2075"**

2075 is 52 years from now. 52 years is a realistically predictable future. One can consider today's human activities and global changes to predict the upcoming future.

- **Define "gradual and Strategic evolution"**

The growth or improvement that takes place in small, increment steps over. i.e. disaster and disease should not be consider. However, climate change or urbanization are example of gradual evolution.

- **Define "Household"**

A group of people who live together in a dwelling unit and typically share common living arrangements, facilities, and expenses. A household can be composed of a single person or multiple individuals.

Question and Answers

- **Who is eligible to participate in the competition?**

Architecture students, and designers are eligible to participate in the competition.

- **What is the maximum number of team members allowed, and can individuals participate on their own?**

Teams can have a maximum of 3 members. Individuals who wish to participate alone can do so by submitting the necessary information as a team leader.

- **Is it possible to make changes after registering?**

Teams are allowed to add new members as long as the total number of members does not exceed 3. However, they are not permitted to swap or remove any existing members. To make changes, please send a request to **competition@361bit.com** with the new member's details and your team's Unique Team Code.

- **Is it allowed for teams to share their work before announcement of winners?**

Teams are only permitted to share their proposals after the winners have been officially announced.

- **What is the modes of submission?**

Participants are asked to submit their work via email to **submission@361bit.com**, in an **A1 size** sheet with a resolution of **300 PPI**. Submissions will only be accepted in digital format.

- **Can participants from unsupported countries use alternative payment methods?**

- **Is the submission of hand-drawn sheets allowed?**
